

SCW Basic Painting Suggestions

2: Nationalist Army

According to Vallejo's Model Color 70 range chart

For all those seeking a painting schema where ultimate colours shown are closer to the base coating applied at start – perhaps more intuitive than those shown at Minairons figures box reverses. Useful too for those willing to be offered multiple choices.

Tip 1: Despite what some guides use to state, do **never** paint helmets as bare metal. Helmet manufacturers always delivered their product as painted.

Tip 2: If your base coat uses to be darker than ultimate layers, then 70-823 or 70-924 are OK for uniforms; otherwise, it would be advisable to choose 70-922 instead (green brightness can be reduced by mixing it with a drop of 70-879 Green Brown).
