201: Catalan Guards

«Reials Guàrdies Catalanes»



Created in November 1705, this elite and bodyguard unit brought together the hardest supporters of Archduke Charles in Catalonia –the so-called «vigatans». This regiment got to have up to 1,000 men in two battalions and was involved in several major battles, such as Almenar (1710), Monte Torrero (1710) and Brihuega-Villaviciosa (1710).

After the signing of Treaty of Utrecht in 1713, the Catalan Guards were formally evacuated to the Kingdom of Naples, but most of its troops chose to stay at home and keep the fight, joining the Regiment of Our Lady of Rosary raisied by the Catalonian Authorities for them.




