## 203: Queen's Own Infantry Regiment

### «Regimiento de La Reina»



This senior regiment of Archduke Charles' Army was raised in Barcelona (Catalonia) in 1705. Little is recorded about their history, except for their defense of Morella town (1707). Following the Treaty of Utrecht, the regiment was withdrawn to Naples (1713), ceasing to exist shortly afterwards.
