205: Valencia Kingdom Infantry Regiment

«Regiment del Regne de València»

Traditionally raised and funded by Valencia City's Municipality, either at king's request or by its own.

It was raised in January 1706 to support Archduke Charles' claim to the throne. After Almansa battle it resulted severely damaged defending the kingdom of Valencia from the Two Crowns invasion. As a result of the heavy losses suffered, it was reformed into Alicante, or Richardi's, Regiment in 1709.
