210: Alacant Town Infantry Regiment

«Regimiento de Alicante» or «Richardi»



Regiment created in October 1706 in the city of Alacant (sp. Alicante), with Lt. Gen. John Richards as its colonel –on whose behalf the regiment was known as «Richardi». Actively involved in all fightings between 1706 and 1709 in the Kingdom of Valencia: sieges of Cartagena (1706), D nia (1707), Alcoi (1707) and Alacant itself (1708-1709). The survivors from this unit were afterwards withdrawn to Catalonia and merged into Ahumada Regiment.

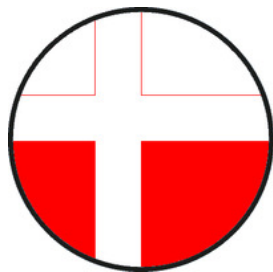
