211: Saragossa City Infantry Regiment

«Regimiento de Zaragoza» or «Alcaudete»

Raised by Saragossa City's Municipality in 1705, to support Archduke Charles' claim to the throne. In 1713 the regiment was evacuated from the Iberian Peninsula and stationed in Lombardy. In 1721, three other Spanish regiments were merged into it (*Ahumada*, *Faber* and *Marulli*) and then became part of the Austrian army.

Aragonese infantry regiments were organized, following Archduke Charles' 1706 Ordinances, in a single battalion totalling in theory a thousand men, divided into 10 companies of fusiliers and 1 of grenadiers.
