229: Rubí's Infantry Regiment

«Regiment del marquès de Rubí»



Regiment raised around July 1713 in Barcelona city by the Viceroy of Majorca, Marquis of Rubí, with the purpose of reinforcing the defenses of the Balearic Islands face a foreseen Bourbon invasion that actually did take place in 1715. It was composed mainly of Catalan volunteers as well as French and Spanish prisoners of war. It surrendered and ceased to exist in 1715.

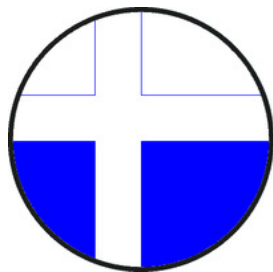
